



Uniform Policy

Purpose:

School uniform is an important part of a school's identity and students should wear it with pride and distinction. Our uniform provides students with a sense of belonging to the Lumen Christi School community. Wearing of the College uniform also creates equality amongst student and eliminates competition and discrimination.

Policy:

The College Uniform has been developed and approved by the College Community Council. It is College policy that students attending Lumen Christi wear our full school uniform with pride. Students are permitted to wear the full sports uniform on their designated sports day.

Parents and carers are asked to support the College Uniform Policy by ensuring that their child has the required uniform and that they wear the uniform neatly and correctly.

Our College Uniform shop is located upstairs in Block 1 of College, enter via the main entrance to the College and follow the signs or ask for directions at the Front Office.

- Wednesday 8:30am-10:00am

Lumen Christi Catholic College Uniform Policy Additional notes:

Jewellery:

- Chains with religious medallions only (not longer than 25mm) worn inside shirt or blouse
- No jewellery to be worn during practical sports classes
- No necklaces, anklets, bangles or wristbands to be worn K to 12
- No rings to be worn K to 10, small signet ring permitted 11/12
- No body jewellery, such as tongue, nose or eyebrow rings, are permitted to be worn K to 12
- Plain (silver or gold) studs or sleeper earrings (no larger than 15 mm) permitted K to 12, one in each ear

Tattoos:

- Tattoos are illegal in NSW for children under 16 years old
- Tattoos must be covered at all times

Hair:

- Extreme hairstyles and hair colours not permitted. (NB: No shorter than number 3 head shave)
- All students to be clean shaven
- Long hair must be tied back
- College hair accessories / blue hair ties only

Make-up:

- No make-up or nail polish to be worn K to 6
- 7 to 12 make-up and nail polish must not be noticeable

Hats:

- The official college hat is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4
- Students are to wear their hat upon leaving the classroom
- Students without hats are to have their name recorded in Sentral
- An optional cap is available for use only during practical PDHPE classes and on official sports days such as swimming and athletics carnivals and when representing the college at the various sporting events
- The cap can only be worn with the official college sports uniform
- The cap is not an alternative to the bucket hat at any other time
- Caps are available in House colours

Blazers:

- Blazers are to be worn to and from school and vice-versa in Terms 2 & 3, to morning PC and for formal occasions
- Blazers should be stored in locked lockers after PC or worn during the day

Mufti Days:

- Uniform free days are held periodically throughout the year
- The money raised on these days is donated to charity organisations supported by the College
- Midriff/singlet tops are not permitted
- Cut-off shorts are not permitted
- Covered footwear, sun safe clothing (including broad brim hats) and modest clothing should be worn
- Students are not to wear clothing with patterns/images/wording of an offensive nature on these days
- Normal college jewelry/hair rules apply

Shoes:

- All shoes must meet OH & S requirements
- Schools shoes must be black, covered in, be below the ankle and polishable (see samples below)
- Sports shoes must be lace up runners, joggers or cross-trainers
- Skate shoes, Dunlop Volleys, canvas or casual shoes not permitted (see samples below)
